§2325. Authorized Games

- A. During a casino night, an organization or private casino contractor may conduct only the following authorized games of chance:
 - 1. Blackjack;
 - 2. Roulette;
- 3. Any dice game where the player competes against the house;
 - 4. Money wheel;
 - 5. Baccarat;
 - 6. Poker; and
 - 7. Bourree.
- B. Nothing shall prohibit an organization from also conducting, during a licensed scheduled casino night, the games of chance authorized by R.S.4:707(A), when such games are conducted in accordance with the Law. The authorized games of chance listed in this Subsection A may not be conducted utilizing any electromechanical device or other mechanism employing cathode ray tubes, video display screens, or microprocessors.
