

§2331. Miscellaneous Provisions

A. In all dice games, the size of each die shall be a minimum of 3/4 inch.

B. Equipment used in the conduct of a casino night shall be maintained in good repair and proper working condition.

C. The utilization of equipment and method of play shall be such that each participant is afforded an equal chance of winning. Marked cards will not be allowed. Marked cards include but are not limited to cards that have been punched, cut, or otherwise defaced.

D. Each game must be conducted by a dealer present at the gaming table. In a family style game, a dealer must be designated for each hand.

E. No organization worker or contract worker shall accept tips, either with real or imitation money, from the participants. However, organizations workers may receive donations for the organization.

F. No organization worker or contract worker shall conduct the game when the worker's immediate family member is a participant at the worker's table.

G. No person under 21 years of age will be permitted to participate in gaming at the casino night. No person under 18 years of age shall be permitted to assist in the conduct of the casino night.

H. No private casino contract worker or organization worker shall be eligible to win prizes or bid on prizes in the event an auction is conducted.
